Embroidery Loft Business of the Month

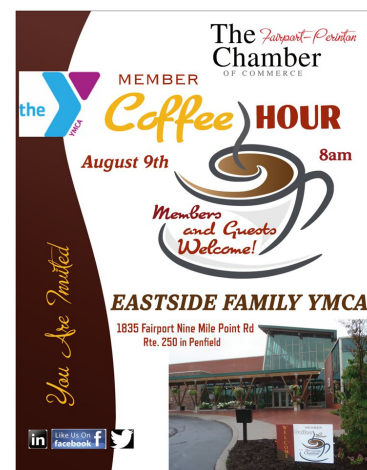
