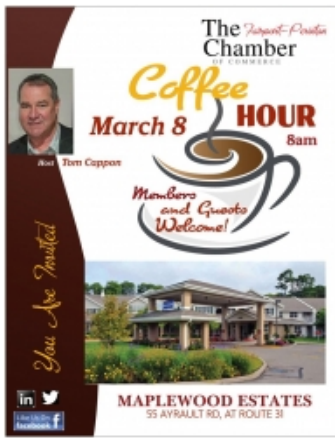

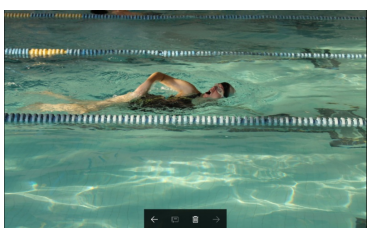

10th Annual Indoor We-Tri Triathlon



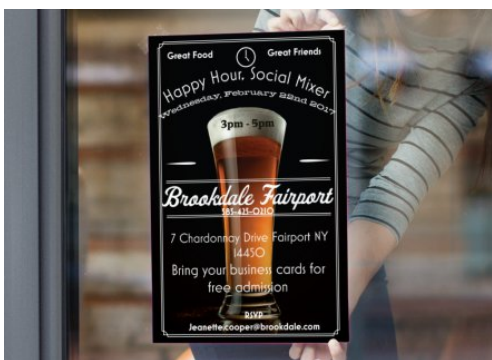
Sunday, April 9 (first heat starts at 7:00am)

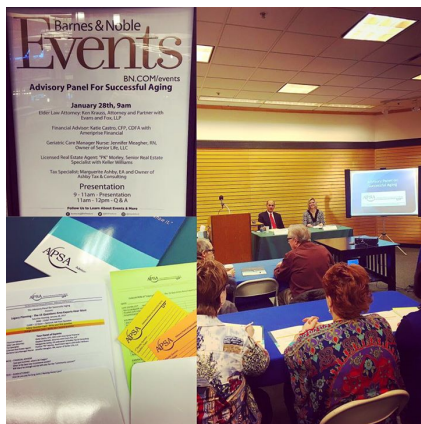
