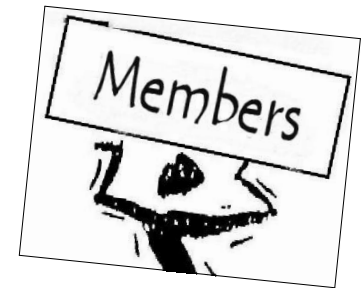
### *Congratulations to Fairport Savings Bank*
